The citrusy, floral bouquet and the rich, malty finish of this exceptional ale was brewed for hopheads by hopheads.

- AVERY, JOE'S AMERICAN PILSNER- Boulder, CO**
Hopped with purpose, this pour is beautifully bitter and dry with an abundance of floral, noble German hops.

- BLUE POINT, HOPTICAL ILLUSION- Long Island, NY**
Features a rare hop exclusively grown on a farm in Oregon- one taste and you'll know why B.P. bought the entire crop.

- BROOKLYN, BLACK CHOCOLATE STOUT- Brooklyn, NY**
Three mashes are brewed into each batch to achieve a luscious dark chocolate flavor through a blend of roasted malts.

Dry and biscuity burnished gold ale in the rare unfiltered "Abbey Singel" style, with a spicy and snappy back end.

Rich Scottish malts bring deep bready flavors to this beer that will have you looking on the bright side of things.

By far the biggest dog in the yard, this dark and malty pour is aged for a minimum of three months before being packaged.

This dark & intriguing Schwarzbier is brewed with Chocolate Malt and German Tettnang hops for a balanced, crisp, clean taste.

Brewed to turn your world upside down, with pungent aromatics and hops that will have you coming and going.

This grand pour has a brilliant deep copper hue and spicy hop aroma with a complex malty finish featuring a dry Simcoe Hop bite.

This Vienna Lager is a New York State Only release- full bodied with a caramel kick.

Brewed with whole flower hops, HopBack is Troeg's flagship beer. Deep amber in color, with a slight floral nose.

Contains a blend of locally roasted espresso and Kenyan coffee beans, resulting in a lush oatmeal stout mouthfeel.
